

PETITION TO THE HOUSE OF COMMONS IN PARLIAMENT ASSEMBLED

According to Government of Canada websites, we are told that:

- Protecting the health and safety of Canadians is of the utmost priority for the Government of Canada. All food products imported into Canada must meet robust health and safety regulations to ensure maximum protection for Canadian consumers. The TPP protects Canada’s right to maintain and implement measures to ensure food safety for consumers as well as to protect animal or plant life or health. Food product imports will only be accepted if they meet Canada’s rigorous health and safety requirements, which have been fully protected.
- Nothing in any of Canada’s Free Trade Agreements (FTAs) exempts foreign investors from having to comply with Canadian laws or regulations.
- TPP will not impair the ability of Canada or its partners to regulate or legislate in areas such as the environment, culture, safety, health and conservation.

Experience shows that these statements by the Government are untrue. As an example, rBGH-induced milk, which is forbidden to be imported into Canada, will be allowed back into this country under the TPP.

rBGH-induced milk is unsafe for human consumption. Claiming it safe is false. rBGH administration to dairy cows generates much increased incidence of mastitis, pus in the milk, and a secondary hormone, IGF-1, incriminated in causing cancer.
